

## Simple construction for Thrown Weapons Target

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### Materials needed:

18' 4x4 post

3x3' 1/2" plywood

(2) sets heavy door hinges

3" screws

3/4" 4x6"x8' board

### Step 1:

Cut 6' of 4x4 post for your stand post

Cut the 4x6" board into 2' lengths for legs.

This forms the basis of your stand. How you attach the leg pieces to the post is up to you. I have mine screwed on thus permanent, but do have thoughts of making the leg pieces separate so that the post can drop in and lock in somehow. Thus making the entire stand 3 complete pieces, easily stored and carried to an event.



**Step 2:**

**Cut the rest of your 4x4 post into 4" blocks.**



**Step 3.**

**Lay your plywood piece onto your main post, set the door hinges, two on top either side and two on the bottom either side of the post. This will allow you to remove the target back from the post either for storage or replacing the 4" 4x4 blocks.**



**Step 4:**

Starting in the lower corner, align the first block, running a 3" screw into the center back till flush. I worked my way up then started back on the next bottom row. Continue till all blocks have been attached.



**Step 5:**

Once you have all the blocks mounted, re-attach to the post. The target back is now very heavy so get help if you need to. Set one hinge pin on top to get started then work round till all are in.

**Step 6:**

Paint you target colors on as per the Marshal/Thrown instructions.
